Welcome to all 2009 NWAL Teams!

Premier Aquatics Club is proud to present **SUMMER THUNDER V**, an NWAL-sanctioned meet. Premier Aquatics Club and NWAL are again offering a pre-seeded timed final meet with electronic timing to provide swimmers with an additional opportunity to qualify for the post season meets. The meet will be held at the Klein Oak High School Pool this year. Indoor setup areas will be available. New this year we will be hosting all 10 and Under events as well as the 11 & Up 100 Free and 100 IM on Sunday afternoon to allow additional time. All other 11 & Up events will be held on Monday evening.

Since this is open to all NWAL teams, we must limit the number of competitors to 900 in order to provide the best conditions for all the swimmers and spectators. Attached you will find the full meet invitation, meet entry form, meet events, and qualifying standards.

Awards will be presented to the top eight competitors for each individual event as well as recognitions for high point by age group.

6&under events – awards for 6 & unders only; **8&under events** – awards for 8 yr olds and 7&unders;
7-8 yr old events – awards for 7yr olds and 8yr olds; **9-10yr old events** – awards for 9yr olds and 10 yr olds
11-12yr old events – awards for 11yr olds and 12 yr olds; **13-14yr events** – awards for 13 yr old and 14 yr old;
15-18yr old events – awards for 15yr & over only.

Event T-shirts will be available for purchase at the venue. Premier Aquatics Club looks forward to your participation in this exciting event.

Directions: : From I-45 exit FM 2920 turn west, drive west on FM 2920, turn right on Gosling and then left on Spring Stuebner. Turn right on Northcrest and then left on Klein Oak Road. The Natatorium is located down the sidewalk near the tennis courts.

POOL: Eight lane, 25 meter indoor pool with non-turbulent lane lines. The venue will also feature an indoor ready bench area and team setup area. The stands in the pool area will be for observation only and **NO SETUP IS ALLOWED**. Please allow others to watch their child after yours has swam. There is no flash photography at the start of a race.

TIME AND DATE: This is a timed-finals meet.

Sunday, June 7th will be for all 10 and Under events and the 11 & Up 100 Free and 100 IM. Warm-up on Sunday will begin at 11:30 p.m. meet starts at 1:00 p.m.

Monday June 8th will be for the remaining 11 and up events. Warm-ups start at 3:45 p.m. and the meet will start at 5:00 p.m.

Split warm-ups will be in effect, with team and lane assignments posted on Premier Aquatics Club's webpage, www.packswimming.com, at least three days prior to the start of the meet or you may call one of the listed meet directors.

OFFICIALS: 2009 NWAL certified officials will officiate. Teams are requested to supply officials and to submit a current officials list with their meet entries

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES: See attached Safety Guidelines and Warm-up

Procedures.

SEEDING: The meet will be a pre-seeded meet. There will be no “on-deck” entries per NWAL rules. All heat and lane assignments will be made prior to the meet. There will be no reseeding at the ready bench. The heat and lane assignments will be shown in the Meet Program, sold on the day of the event. The coaches must turn in relay cards with either no changes or with any swimmer and time adjustments by 2 pm on Sunday and 5 pm on Monday.

If any swimmer changes are made on the relays, it is the coach’s responsibility to ensure sure only swimmers qualified for that leg in Summer Thunder are used for each swim. All swimmers must be shown in the order in which they will swim on the relay. Relay swimmers **MUST** already be entered in the meet to be added to a Relay the day of the meet when Relay changes are submitted to *the Computer Room*.

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entry Times: Swimmers must enter with their best time. Entry times must be submitted in the course at which the best time was achieved – short course yards (Y) or short course meters (S). Do not convert meter times to yard times or visa versa. Entry times should not be converted by the entrant – they will be converted to the proper course by the host team using the default conversions in Hy-Tek.) If entries are made by paper (not using Hy-Tek), swimmers should indicate on their entry the course at which the entry time was made (i.e., Y or S). If best time was achieved at a pool that is not the standard 25 meter or 25 yard pool, please contact the meet entry coordinator for conversions and entry instructions.

Qualifying Times: This Invitational Meet is designed to encourage and foster competitive Summer League Swimming. All swimmers 13 years and older are invited to attend regardless of seed times. Swimmers 12 years and younger must have achieved minimum qualifying times in the attached order of events. Relay participants must meet the qualifying time for his/her leg of the relay. **Time Trial times WILL be allowed. NTs (No Times) will not be allowed. Swimmers that qualify for 3 events will be allowed to swim all additional events provided they have an actual time swum at a time trial or a sanctioned NWAL meet. Again NTs will not be accepted. Note regarding the 12 & Under 100 Free.** The 12 & under 100 Free is exempt from the (3) event rule. Swimmers must achieve the time standard in order to enter the event.

Number of Events: NWAL Rules will apply with the following clarifications: (1) There is no limit to the number of individual events in which a swimmer may enter. (2) Teams may enter up to two relay teams in each relay event. Any relay team is eligible to score points for the team score.

Deadline: **Entries will be accepted on Sunday, May 31, 2009 from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM VIA EMAIL.** Any entry received prior to 9:00 am will be returned. Checks must be received by **Tuesday June 2nd, at Noon.** Do not send checks via Federal Express, etc., that require a signature; If you must send your checks by express mail, please indicate that a signature is NOT required. Send checks to the Meet Entry Chairman at the address listed below. For any team where the check was not received on time, that team will be dropped from the meet at the meet director’s discretion. If a team is removed due to failure to submit fees, the meet director will reserve the right to add the next team(s) that submitted entries originally but was not allowed to enter due to swimmer count limits.

Entries: All teams **MUST** submit their entries via email, CD or Flash Drive, (Floppy Disk will NOT be accepted) using the Hy-Tek Meet Manager/Team Manager computer software, along with a hard copy printout of the entries. Include relays and relay-only swimmers on your completed entry form, CD. **Meet entries will be limited to 900 Total swimmers on a first come first serve basis.** The team that comprises the 900th swimmer will be allowed to fully enter the meet after which no teams shall be permitted to enter.

Teams with **ANY** swimmers who do not submit their entries via electronic media must remit a \$25 surcharge along with their entry fees . Summer Thunder is not responsible for any times mis-entered manually and **WILL NOT** reseed any event due to entry error. Teams are strongly encouraged to submit all entries electronically using the Hy-Tek Team Manager software.

Eligible Teams: All NWAL teams.

Fees: \$4.00 per Individual Event and \$8.00 for each Relay event. Make checks payable to **Premier Aquatics Club**. Entry fees must accompany entries.

AWARDS: **Individual events:** Medals for individual 1st – 8th place. (Awards to 6&U, 7, 8, 9, 10,11,12,13,14, and 15-18) **Relay events:** Medals for 1st – 3rd place. **High Point Awards** will be given to the boy and girl in each age group earning the highest points (6&U, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13,14, 15-18). In the event of a tie, the tie-breaker will be the swimmer with the most 1st place finishes. If that is a tie, then the number of second place finishes will be used, and so on until the tie is broken. **Team Awards:** High point trophies will also be awarded to the top three teams in two divisions (Divisions will be based on number of swimmers/entries and will be determined after entries are received.) Ties will be broken by same method used in high point awards.

SCORING: Individual Events: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay Events: 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2

RULES AND SANCTIONS: The 2009 NWAL rules will apply. The meet will be held under the sanction of the NWAL League Officers and Board of Directors. No entries can be accepted unless the entrant is a member of registered NWAL team. **The three (3) event rule does apply.** Once swimmers have qualified in three individual events, the swimmer is eligible to enter unlimited individual events. However, the swimmer must have an actual time in that event. Time Trial times will be accepted but NT's will NOT be accepted. Teams may enter as many as 2 relays and all relays are eligible to score points.

All participants must be registered 2009 NWAL swimmers. All participants must have competed in at least one NWAL meet during the 2009 NWAL season. Eligibility for an age group is determined by the individual's age as of the end of May 31, 2009 per NWAL rules.

Note regarding the 12 & Under 100 Free. The 12 & under 100 Free is exempt from the (3) event rule. Swimmers must achieve the time standard in order to enter the event.

TIMING SYSTEM: A Colorado Model 5000 or 6000 electronic timing system with electronic scoreboard will be used. Two watches per lane will be used as a back-up. Teams will be required to furnish timers based on their percentage of swims at the meet. Timing assignments will be published in the Heat sheet and on the Premier Aquatic's website (www.packswimming.com) prior to the meet.

POOL DECK RESTRICTION: Because of Insurance Safety Regulations, the swimming pool deck, during the operation of the Summer Thunder swim meet, is closed to all persons except swimmers, coaches, marshals, officials, meet personnel, and timers. If you are asked to leave the deck by any meet personnel, please do so. It is for your safety.

Coaches and Officials may receive complimentary Heat Sheets and admission to the Hospitality Room.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES: Coaches and/or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee of any disability prior to the competition and for providing their own assistant or equipment. However, Coaches/Swimmers may contact the Meet Director at least two weeks in advance of the meet to help arrange any additional equipment.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available.

HOSPITALITY: A hospitality room will be available.

MEET SETUP: Air Conditioned inside setup will be available in the "commons" area of the high school.

MERCHANDISE: Premier Aquatics Club or a vendor permitted by Premier Aquatics will be selling apparel and swim gear. A Summer Thunder shirt will be on sale as well.

MEET RESULTS: Meet results will be posted on the Premier Aquatics Club Web Page (www.packswimming.com) as well at the NWAL Web Page (<http://www.nwal.org/>) within two days after the conclusion of the meet.

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES

WARM-UP PROCEDURES

- A. General warm-up (Initial portion [1/2] of the warm-up session or with the agreement of all of the coaches in a particular lane.)
 - 1 **NO DIVING OR RACING STARTS** allowed from the blocks edge of the pool. Swimmers must enter the pool feet first cautiously.
 - 2 **NO SPRINTING OR PACE WORK** allowed during this general warm-up session.
- B. Specific warm-up (Last portion [1/2] of the warm-up session or with the agreement of all of the coaches in a particular lane.)
 - 1 **RACING STARTS ONLY**, either from blocks or from backstroke starts.
 - 2 Lanes are **ONE WAY ONLY**.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- A. Swimmers Responsibilities
 - 1. All unattached or unattended swimmers, and/or their coaches, should arrange, prior to their arrival at the meet, for a certified coach to observe them during the warm-up, competition and warm-down. Any unattached or unattended swimmers who have not made previous arrangements with a coach to observe them at the meet should contact the Meet Director, Safety Marshal or Meet Referee for assistance in making such arrangements prior to their participating in the warm-up.
- B. Coaches Responsibilities
 - 1 Coaches shall instruct their swimmers regarding safety guidelines and warm-up procedures as they apply to conduct at meets and practice.
 - 2 Coaches shall stand near the starting end of the pool when starting swimmers on sprint and pace work.
 - 3 Coaches shall actively supervise their swimmers throughout the warm-up session.
 - 4 Coaches shall maintain as much contact with their swimmers as possible, both verbal and visual, throughout the warm-up period.
- C. Safety Marshals
 - 1. Appointed Safety Marshals have the authority to remove from the deck for the remainder of the warm-up session, any swimmer or coach who is in violation of safety guidelines or warm-up procedures. **THE MEET REFEREE MAY EXERCISE ADDITIONAL ADJUDICATION AUTHORITY AS NECESSARY.**
- D. Miscellaneous
 - 1 Swimmers should be reminded by coaches that breaststrokers need more lead time than freestyle or butterfly swimmers.
 - 2 Backstrokers shall ensure that they are not starting at the same time as a swimmer on the blocks. Swimmers shall not step up on the starting blocks, when a backstroker is waiting to start.
 - 3 Swimmers shall not jump or dive into the pool to stop another swimmer on a recalled start.
 - 4 Swimmers are required to exit the pool upon completion of their warm-up to allow other swimmers adequate warm-up time. The pool is not for visiting or playing during warm-up periods.
 - 5 Warm-up procedures shall be enforced for any breaks, scheduled or otherwise, during the competition.
 - 6 All diving boards and equipment are **OFF LIMITS**.
- E. Pool Rules
 - 1 Smoking or use of other tobacco products is not allowed on the grounds of Klein ISD
 - 2 Glass containers are prohibited.
 - 3 Swimmers, coaches, and spectators are expected to observe all rules and regulations included in the invitation.
